## Help to Grow Management

The course is open to managers and business leaders to help boost business performance, resilience and long-term growth. By the end of the course, participants will develop a business growth plan to lead their organisation to achieve its full potential. The 12-week course has been designed to allow participants to complete it alongside full-time work. It is 90% funded by the Government and the fee payable by participants is £750.

## Trade waste recycling

The District Council will be introducing food waste and recycling collections for businesses from 1st April 2025.

The service will be offered to all business premises in the Derbyshire Dales but please be aware that from 1 April 2025, all businesses in the UK with over 10 full-time equivalent employees will by law, have to segregate their food waste and recycling for a separate collection.

- Businesses will be required to separate their food waste from other waste streams.
- Businesses will also need to separate their dry recyclables, such as paper, card, plastic, metal and glass.
- Food waste and dry recyclables will need to be collected separately from general waste.

We will communicate with our current trade waste customers to ensure they remain compliant.

We're also asking business owners in the Derbyshire Dales to fill in our online survey before 31<sup>st</sup> October, so we can better understand your trade waste requirements.
